Vallabh Ashram owes its existence to the roots embedded by Sangeet Sudhakar Late Poojya Swami Vallabhdasji, a renowned Indian Classical music exponent who devoted his life for music and education.



Initiating the first step, **Shreevallabh ShikshanSangeet Ashram, at Sion (Mumbai) was established in 1949.**

It was in 1976 when the ardent desire of our founder Poojya Swami Shreevallabhdasji being visualized by his disciple Poojya Swami Shree Hariprasaddasji made it possible to sow the visualized seeds of mission on the barren land of 28 acres on N.H. No.8, KillaPardi, Dist. Valsad, that sprouted as 'Vallabh Ashram Education Centre'. The journey of the school started with the aim of imparting quality and value based education to the rural children. Shreevallabh Ashram has been in the forefront for imparting educational and social services.

The completion of 40 years is indeed a major milestone in the educational field. We haven't left any avenue unexplored to provide quality education with a harmonious blend of modern technology instilled with Indian culture and values.

Today **Shreevallabh Ashram's M G M Amin & V N Savani School (1976)** stands proudly as a well-established institution leading socio-cultural centre in the field of education. Spread over a land of 45 acres, Vallabh Ashram's M G M Amin and V N Savani School, is a co-educational, residential (only for boys from classes VI-XII)- cum- day I-XII school. It is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, Bharat with 2000+ strength. The school is a member of the prestigious organizations, like, IPSC and NPSC.

Shreevallabh Ashram's MLM Patel Balmandir (1976), the preprimary wing of Vallabh Ashram International Education Centre, runs its Playgroup, Lower K.G. and Upper K.G. classes. With an approach to induct students into the mainstream of higher education, this section is continually engaged in teaching with new techniques to children with ideal Student Teacher Ratio to help them grow in a modern competitive world with a positive outlook. The Montessori Teaching method of the school seeks to groom a child's personality and increase his social awareness.

It had been a long cherished dream of Poojya Swami Shree Hariprasaddasji to provide education to girls and empowering them to achieve their highest potential. This fully residential CBSE affiliated girls' school spread over 12 acres of serene campus was established in the year 2004 which now stands with a strength of 400+ girls and 150+ boys (Classes I-V). **The School Believes in** cultivating core values in the young minds, also to help to energize and channelize women power in the task of nation building today.



Shreevallabh Sanskar Dham's Smt. Shobhaben Pratapbhai Day Boarding School (2011)

Answering the growing demand of parents for a day-cum-boarding school,

this CBSE affiliated school was established in the year 2011 to relieve working parents of their wards concerns. Education, meals, homework, remedial teaching and an all-round development of children is provided for under one roof with excellent results. The present strength of the school has crossed 800 students. The school is an ideal repository for children with working parents.



Shreevallabh Ashram's Shala (Tribal School) (1989)

Ashram Shala (Tribal School) is a Gujarati medium school from classes I-VIII established in 1989 at Village Balda, Taluka Killa Pardi, District Valsad with the prime aim of providing free education to Adivasi



folks and raising their standard and quality of life. 150+ Tribal Adivasi students are given free education with free medical and residential facilities thereby improving their living standard and making them capable to settle in their lives. The students here are been specially trained for Gau-

Palan and are been skilled with basics of farming and gardening.

Shreevallabh Gaushala Trust (1985)

Worshipper and devotee of Lord Krishna, Poojya Swamiji took up an initiative of cow protection and to enhance the same. Two Gaushalas - one at Village Balda, Taluka Pardi, Dist. Valsad and the other at Village Nana Waghchhipa, Taluka Pardi, District Valsad, breed pure Gir cows including HF cows and Cross Breed cows with a number exceeding 300. The purpose is to provide cow milk and dairy products to the tribal and residential students. The trust take steps to educate the local poor people and farmers about cattle rearing. The motto of this gaushala is to rear cows and carry on the age old cultural tradition of Gau Pooja and to provide employment to the local village people. The trust also provides the calf at very nominal cost or at times free to the poor village farmers which can help them to get milk for their children and big bulls can be used for agriculture purpose thereby enabling them to earn their living and improve their standard of living.



Medical Centre (2007)

Poojya Swamiji and Dr. H. C. Merchant have taken up the philanthropic service of rendering free medical help and facilities to adivasis and poor people. A medical centre has been established at Nana Waghchhipa, Taluka Pardi, District Valsad where a qualified doctor couple (MBBS) gives treatment to 50-70 patients daily. Free check-up and medicines are made available to people. During the year our trust organizes different types of Medical Camps like Heart Check-up Camp, Diabetic Camps, Hyper Tension Camps, Blood Pressure Camps, Full Body Check-up Camps, Surgical Camps, etc. with the aim to serve the needy and poor tribal people who can't afford medical treatments.



Shreevallabh Ashram's Smt. Shobhaben Pratapbhai Patel School (Billimora) (2018)

Sustaining its primary aim of providing modern quality education instilled with Indian Culture and Values to the rural children, Vallabh Ashram has stepped up further with a Proposed CBSE, Bharat School at Bilimora, presently with Pre-Primary (June'2018) and Classes 1 to 7 (April' 2019)
